A Sheriff Community Oriented Policing (S.C.O.P.E.) Medical Lake / Espanola community program in partnership with the Spokane County Sheriff's Office to encourage S.C.O.P.E. volunteers to assist with and participate in community events. Contact the S.C.O.P.E. station if you would like assistance at your event. Examples of our participation are :

- Founders Day – S.C.O.P.E. volunteers registered parade participants and provided security along the parade route at this annual event.
- Founders Day - S.C.O.P.E. Medical Lake / Espanola volunteers operate an Operation Family ID booth at each year.
- Medical Lake Food Bank - S.C.O.P.E. Medical Lake / Espanola volunteers assisted with flagging & traffic control during the summer of 2008.
- Shred-A-Thon - In partnership with the Washington State Employees Credit Union (WSECU). WSECU provides an opportunity to bring unneeded documents to a central location in Medical Lake for professional, secure shredding. Our S.C.O.P.E. volunteers join in this annual event by offering Operation Family ID.
- Triathlons – Each year several triathlon events occur in our community. S.C.O.P.E. volunteers provide traffic control & flagging when needed.
- Bicycle Safety Fair – annual summer event sponsored by S.C.O.P.E. Medical Lake / Espanola to provide donated bicycle helmets to children, ages 12 and under, educate them about bicycle safety, practice their bicycle skills on a special obstacle course and be eligible for a drawing for prizes.
