



## **S.C.O.P.E. Medical Lake / Espanola Community Services Program**

### **Operation Family ID (OFID)**

A Sheriff Community Oriented Policing (S.C.O.P.E.) Medical Lake / Espanola local community service program in partnership with the Spokane County Sheriff's Office to help identify preschool and elementary school children. The Operation Family ID (OFID) program works as follows:

- Parent or legal guardian completes a personal history card of the child.
- The child is fingerprinted on a card by a trained S.C.O.P.E. volunteer.
- The child is digitally photographed by a trained S.C.O.P.E. volunteer. The photo is placed on a diskette. (Photos should be updated yearly).
- Parent or legal guardian is given a special packet, for safekeeping, containing the personal history card, fingerprint card and digital photograph diskette of the child.
- The digital photo, fingerprints and personal history card can be used by law enforcement to help return the child safely home in the event of disappearance or abduction.
- This is no charge for this community service program. However, donations are gladly accepted.
